FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

NS/NT PAJERO 10/06on TYPE 8, 76MM NUDGE BAR & 63MM SERIES 2 NUDGE BAR

VEHICLE FRONTAL PROTECTION SYSTEM (VFPS) FOR AIR BAG & ADR COMPLIANT VEHICLES

Check installation hardware before commencing.

NOTE: On drivers side of Exceed model, there is a siren box mounted to the outside of the chassis rail. The mounting bolts, although they look like rivets are actually M8 bolts with a break away section for security. To remove these bolts, drill with small drill and use "an easy out". Or a second method is, with small chisel, place a slit in the outer edge of the rivet section. Use the chisel or a punch to rotate the rivet section to undo the bolt. Remove from vehicle. **See figures 1 and 2.**

- 1. Remove protection guard from tow bracket area.
- 2. Remove front of inner guards. Two plastic screw clips and one 10mm head bolt (flare to inner guard), three plastic clips (chassis rail), two plastic clips on lower inner guard (each side). Fold *inner guard clear* of chassis.
- 3. Turn wheel outward for easier access. For drivers side on exceed model, remove lower security bolt from siren box. Bend siren box away from vehicle at bottom.
- 4. Position steel mounting brackets (supplied) on outside of chassis approximately <u>5mm rearward from edge</u> of 25mm hole in lower front chassis. For drivers side, insert M8 x 30 bolt, spring washer, M8 flat washer and M10 flat washer into front hole in mount and lower hole in siren.
- 5. Mark centre of rear most slot hole on chassis. Centre punch and drill 10mm hole through outer chassis only. **See figures 3 and 4.**
- 6. Insert 3/8 x 1 1/2 bolt/washer on wire (supplied) (bend to suit), through lower 25mm chassis hole and out of 10mm hole just drilled. **See figure 5 NOTE:** 25mm access hole in chassis may need to be enlarged. Use die grinder or similar.
- 7. Position steel mounting brackets on bolt with bolt in centre of slot hole. Use 3/8 nut/washers (supplied) and **TIGHTEN IN POSITION**. Ensuring steel flat welded off steel mounting brackets is hard up against lower chassis.
- 8. On passenger side, drill forward hole in centre of slot hole on mount through chassis. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolt/washer on wire (supplied). **FINGER TIGHTEN ONLY.**
- 10. Position protection bar on inside of steel mounts. **See figure 6.** Install two 3/8 x 1 ½ bolts and nuts (supplied) for rear holes, swing protection bar up into position. Align in position with vehicle and **TIGHTEN BOLTS**. **NOTE: See figures 7, 9 and 11** for front views and **figures 8, 10 and 12** for side views.
- 11. If necessary, loosen rear nut on steel mount to allow steel mount to move on chassis for extra adjustment. Drill forward holes in centre of protection bar tube using steel mount as a guide. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolts with nuts on wire (supplied).

12. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS.

- 13. Trim wire off on mount bolts leaving approximately 50mm of wire out of access hole.
- 14. Refit protection guard to vehicle.
- 15. Refit plastic inner guards to vehicle.

ENSURE NUMBER PLATE IS CLEARLY VISABLE

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

Further VFPS Notes:

- a) Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).
- b) Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- c) Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- d) Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- e) No accessory or fitment should project forward of the VFPS forward profile.
- f) ENSURE THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE LEFT WITH VEHICLE OWNER AND/OR OPERATOR.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Periodically check bolts and nuts for correct tightness, especially if travelling on rough roads

FITTING KIT

2 – Steel mounting brackets.	10 - 3/8 flat washers.
$3 - 3/8 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ bolts/washer on 250mm wire	7 - 3/8 spring washers.
$4 - 3/8 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ bolts	1 – M8 x 30 bolt
7 - 3/8 nuts.	1 – M8 spring washer
2-3/8 nuts/washer on wire.	1 – M8 flat washer
