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

# **Product Care**

#### **Polished Products**

Being a premium mirror polished finish, regular maintenance will be required to keep that iconic ECB shine. We recommend using our own brand of Aluminium Polish. This formula has been tried and tested and in our opinion is the world's best standard.

**Directions:** Apply a small quantity of Aluminium Polish to a clean soft cloth and rub the metal surface. The longer the rubbing the brighter the surface becomes. Wipe off Aluminium Polish with clean soft cloth. Also suitable for motorised buffing machines.

Note: There are more specific details on the polish bottle. Please read before use.

#### **Powdercoated Products**

# Stage 1.

- Test drive vehicle to ensure all driver assists are correctly working and to gauge effectiveness. Park on a flat level surface.
- · Apply parking brake and lift bonnet.
- Unwrap ECB Protection bar and disconnect mounts. Discard bolts.
- Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.



# Stage 2.

- Remove five (5) push/pull clips and two (2) T30 torx head screws from top radiator trim.
- Carefully lift up on front of trim to release clips from grille and remove trim.



# Stage 3.

 Remove four (4) 10mm head bolts from grille and remove grille.




# Stage 4.

• Remove four (4) T20 torx head screws from front of wheel arch liner per/side.



# Stage 5.

- Remove foglight by removing three (3)
   T20 torx head screws per/side.
- Remove fog light surround by unclipping clips from behind and pulling from front.



# Stage 6.

- Remove two (2) 10mm head bolts from under side of bumper centre trim.
- Remove bumper centre trim by carefully pulling forward.



# Stage 7.

- Remove two (2) 13mm head bolts from behind centre bumper trim per side and one (1) 15mm head bolt from behind fog light trim.
- · Remove bumper.



# Stage 8.

- Unplug wiring from under side of bumper reinforcement.
- Remove one (1) plastic clip from inside of chassis rail near the coolers (per side). Remove two (2) 15mm head bolts from end of chassis rail (per side) and remove bumper reinforcement and air shoot.



# Stage 9.

 Remove four (4) 15mm head bolts from under body guard and remove.



# Stage 10.

- Remove two (2) 8mm head bolts from air dams (per side) and remove air dams
- Mark and trim the smallest amount possible from air dam to fit around ECB steel mounting bracket.
- Refit to vehicle using original equipment.



# Stage 11.

- Remove eighteen (18) 10mm head bolts from bumper stifner to unclip wiring loom.
- Relocate wiring loom onto lower tie bar rail below intercooler using zip ties (supplied).



# Stage 12.

 Remove one (1) 7mm head bolt from FM antenna behind bumper and relocate onto drivers side lower headlight panel.



#### Stage 13.

- Fit ECB steel winch mounting bracket (supplied) to front of chassis by sliding down from top of chassis.
- Rear of steel winch mounting bracket will be tight on outside of chassis. This is an expansion fit. It is important that the mount is level and lined up square with the vehicle body.
- Fit two (2) M10 x 1.5 x 30mm bolts, spring washers, flat washers and nuts (supplied) in outer holes. Finger tighten only.



# Stage 14.

- Using mount as a guide drill two (2) 10mm holes, rear leg on mount to chassis rail.
- Enlarge holes on inside of chassis rail to suit the sizing of the chassis spacing tube (supplied).

Blow filings clear and treat all exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.



# Stage 15.

- Fit four (4) holes with M10 x 1.5 x 40mm bolts, spring washers, flat washers (supplied).
- Install two (2) M10 x 1.5 x 100mm bolts, flat washers, spacer tubes, spring washers and nuts (supplied) to holes on side of chassis (per side).
- Align winch mounting bracket to front of vehicle and tighten all bolts.



# Stage 16.

 Install winch mounting bracket support brackets to the rear of winch mounting bracket using two (2) M12 x 1.75 x 40mm bolts, flat washers, spring washers and nuts (supplied).



# Stage 17.

 Fit fairlead and winch to winch cradle using equipment supplied with the winch.

NOTE: Included in the fitting kit is a control box bracket designed for older warn winches. This control box bracket mounts to the motor side of the winch using worm drive hose clamps (supplied). Newer center mount control boxes should not need this bracket.



# Stage 18.

· Refit grille using original equipment.



# Stage 19.

- Disconnect indicator and parking lights on vehicle. Install ECB quick click wiring harnesses (supplied) between disconnected harness and indicator / park lights on vehicle. Run wiring out from under lights ensuring clearance from sharp edges and moving parts.
- Disconnect fog light on vehicle. Install ECB quick click harness (supplied) onto bumper light and wiring harness.

# Stage 20.

 Fit ECB LED indicator / park lights into protection bar as per instructions supplied with the LED indicator kit.
 NOTE: Ensure park light is to top.



# Stage 21.

 Attach 6mm clip lock trim (supplied) to top of ECB protection bar. NOTE: Trim off lower edge on an angle so trim will sit flush with end of protection bar.







# Stage 22.

- Fit ECB protection bar to winch mounting bracket using four (4) M12 x 1.75 x 40mm bolts, spring washers, flat washers and nuts (supplied) (per side).
- · Aligh protection bar and tighten all bolts.




# Stage 23.

- Attach ECB bumper lights to protection bar. Place M6 x 20 bolts, spring washers (supplied) through light mount from inside and attach nut to top. Slide assembly into light mount in Protection bar and centralize light to hole. TIGHTEN FIRM ONLY.
- Install bumper light surrounds (supplied) to bumper light openings and winch openings.
   Large side of surround to inside of opening on lights and to rounded side of winch openings.



# Stage 24.

- Fit ECB under body guard (supplied) using original equipment. The front of guard sits on top of steel mounting bracket.
- In front holes use two (2) M10 x 1.5 x 30mm bolts, flat washer, spring washer and nut and washer on wire (supplied) (per side).



# Final Checks & Installation Kit

# **Ensure Number Plate is Clearly Visable**

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

#### **Further VFPS Notes**

- Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).
- Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- 3. Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- 4. Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- 5. No accessory or fitment should project forward of the VFPS forward profile.
- 6. Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.

#### **Important Information**

Periodically check bolts and nuts for correct tightness, especially if traveling on rough roads.


