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

Product Care

Polished Products

Being a premium mirror polished finish, regular maintenance will be required to keep that iconic ECB shine. We recommend using our own brand of Aluminium Polish. This formula has been tried and tested and in our opinion is the world's best standard.

Directions: Apply a small quantity of Aluminium Polish to a clean soft cloth and rub the metal surface. The longer the rubbing the brighter the surface becomes. Wipe off Aluminium Polish with clean soft cloth. Also suitable for motorised buffing machines.

Note: There are more specific details on the polish bottle. Please read before use.

Stage 1

- Test drive vehicle to ensure all driver assists are correctly working and to gauge effectiveness. Park on a flat level surface.
- · Apply parking brake and lift bonnet.
- Unwrap ECB Protection bar and disconnect mounts. Discard bolts.
- Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.



Stage 2

 Top of grill remove seven (7) T15 Torx screws.



- Inner wheel arch remove four (4) T15 Torx screws per side.
- Pull gaurd lining away to expose one (1)
 7mm head screw top of bottom of gaurd and top of bumper.



Stage 4

- Underside of bumper remove ten (10)
 7mm head screws.
- In lower grill remove two (2) 7mm head screws.





- Unplug sensor and camera on drivers side.
- Unclip heat sensor harness from lower bumper support and grill.





- · Pull flare away from bumper.
- Gentley pull side wing away from car and forward to remove bumper.



Stage 7

- Unplug sonar. Remove three (3) 7mm head screws from sonar unit mount from bumper support.
- Remove sonar from mount three (3) 10mm nuts.



Stage 8

- Working on one side at a time, remove four
 (4) 13mm head bolts from bumper support.
- Slide ECB steel mounting bracket (supplied) between chassis and bumper support.
- Use M10 x 1.50 x 35mm bolts, flat washers and spring washers (supplied) in outer holes only. Finger tighten only.
- · Repeat for opposite side.



- On inner holes attach mount support bracket (supplied) using 30mm spacers (supplied) between bumper support and bracket secure with M10 x1.50 x 70mm bolt, flat washer and spring washer (supplied). Attach to mounting bracket using M10 x 1.5 x 35mm bolt, flat washer, spring washer and nuts (supplied).
- Check measure outside measurement of mounts on protection bar. Align inner measurement on steel mounting brackets to suit.
- · Tighten all bolts.




Stage 10

 Remove Camera from bumper two (2) T20 Torx screws.



Stage 11

- Place camera into protection bar and secure with 8G x 20 self-drilling screws (supplied).
- · Do not over tighten.



- Remove sensor and camera harness from bumper and place into protection har
- Use zip ties (supplied) to secure harness to protection bar.
- · Do not over tighten.



Stage 13

- Rotate parking sensor mount to suit direction parking sensor was removed from vehicle.
 Ensure silicon ring is attached to front of sensor. With parking sensor in correct direction, gently place into parking sensor mount with locating pins ratcheting into holding lugs. Push only until front of sensor is aligned with front of parking sensor mount. Silicon seat on parking sensor should seat loosely into front opening.
- Zip tie rear of sensor. CAUTION: Pulling zip ties to tight can cause sensor to give false readings.



Stage 14

- Measure distance outside steel mounting bracket and carefully trim lower grill to allow mount fitment.
- Tape area to be trimmed to avoid any damage.




- Remove fog lights from bumper for camera and light wiring. Gently pull fog lights to release clips.
- Remove sonar harness from water bottle by pulling out christmas tree clip.



Stage 16

 Splice ECB wiring harness into wiring harness behind headlight using cable locks (supplied). Ensure harness is clear of sharp edges and moving parts.

Stage 17

 Refit bumper in revese as per steps 2 to 4.



Stage 18

 Fit ECB LED indicator / park lights into protection bar as per instructions supplied with the LED indicator kit.
 NOTE: Ensure park light is to top.



Stage 19

- Attach ECB bumper lights to protection bar. Place M6 x 20 bolts, spring washers (supplied) through light mount from inside and attach nut to top. Slide assembly into light mount in Protection bar and centralize light to hole. TIGHTEN FIRM ONLY.
- Install bumper light surrounds (supplied) to fog light openings with large side of surround to inside of opening.



Stage 20

 Attach 6mm clip lock trim (supplied) to top of ECB protection bar. NOTE: Trim off lower edge on an angle so trim will sit flush with end of protection bar.







- Fit protection bar to steel mounts using M12 x 1.50 x 40mm bolts, flat washers and spring washers and nuts (supplied). Finger tighten only.
- Align protection bar with vehicle.
 Tighten all bolts.



Stage 22

- Mount sonar and plastic cover onto sonar mount (supplied) using three (3) x M6x
 50 bolts, flat washers, nuts and nyloc nuts (supplied) to secure sonar to mount.
- Fit sonar and bracket to top fo lower leg of protection bar through air vent using M6 x 25mm bolts, flat washers and nyloc nuts (supplied).
- Connect harness and ensure harness is clear of sharp edges and moving parts.



- Connect camera, indicator/ park/ DRL lights and bumper lights.
- Ensure camera and all lights operate correctly.
- Test drive vehicle to ensure all driver aids work as per manufacturers specifications.



Final Checks & Installation Kit

Ensure Number Plate is Clearly Visable

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

Further VFPS Notes

- Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).
- Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- 3. Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- 4. Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- 5. No accessory or fitment should project forward of the VFPS forward profile.
- 6. Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.


