Polished Products

Being a premium mirror polished finish, regular maintenance will be required to keep that iconic ECB shine. We recommend using our own brand of Aluminium Polish, This formula has been tried and tested and in our opinion is the world's best standard.

Directions: Apply a small quantity of Aluminium Polish to a clean soft cloth and rub the metal surface. The longer the rubbing the brighter the surface becomes. Wipe off Aluminium Polish with clean soft cloth. Also suitable for motorised buffing machines. Note: There are more specific details on the polish bottle. Please read before use.

Stage 1

- Test drive vehicle to ensure all driver assists are correctly working and to gauge effectiveness. Park on a flat level surface.
- Apply parking brake and lift bonnet.
- Unwrap ECB Protection bar and disconnect mounts. Discard bolts.
- CAUTION. HEADLIGHT WASHER CAPS MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE BUMPER IS UNCLIPPED FROM GUARD.



Stage 2

- Remove nine (9) 10 mm head bolts from under body guard and let hang.
- Remove headlight washer covers from bumper skin by gently pulling washer from bumper, then uncliping from shaft.



Stage 3

- Remove two (2) 10mm head bolts from outer edge of grille, four (4) black push pull clips from top of radiator panel, one (1) Philips screw from rear wing (per side). Six (6) 10 mm head bolts from underside of bumper, three (3) push pull clips from front of guard liner per side.
- Unplug bumper lights and parking sensors if required. Remove headlight washer caps from headlight washers. Carefully pull out on rear wing to unclip away from guard, pull forward to unclip away from headlight and remove bumper from vehicle.



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Stage 4

- Unplug air temperature sensor, horn, radar unit and headlight washer line.
- Remove two (2) 10 mm head nuts and eight (8) 12 mm head bolts from bumper support.
- Remove bumper support.



Stage 5

- Remove lower stiffener from bumper support, two (2) 10mm head nuts (per side).
- Refit onto ECB steel mount using four (4) M6 x 30 bolts, flat washers spring washers and nuts (supplied).



Stage 6

• Remove lower half of air dams to allow ECB Steel mount to fit, six (6) 10 mm head bolts and three (3) push pull clips.



Stage 7

- Fit ECB steel mount onto end of chassis rail using eight (8) M8 x 40 bolts, flat washers and spring washers (supplied).
- Centralise mount to vehicle and tighten bolts.



Stage 8

• Fit horn onto ECB steel mount using (1) one M6 x 30 bolt, flat washers, spring washer and nut (supplied).



Stage 9

• Fit air temperature sensor unit onto ECB steel mount





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Stage 10

• Remove headlight washer line from bumper support if required and fix in rear of protection bar with zip ties.



Stage 11

 Extend camera wiring harness with 5 core wire and solder connectors (supplied).



Stage 12

 Remove camera from bumper and relocate into protection bar with original equipment screws.



Stage 13

- Remove sonar unit from bumper support and disassemble, fit onto ECB alloy mount using four original Philips head screws.
- Fit sonar mount onto protection bar with Perspex cover plate in front with three (3) M6 bolts, flat washers and one nyloc nut, two nuts on wire.



Stage 14

 Remove parking sensors and parking sensor harness from the back of bumper. Run original equipment wiring harness into rear of ECB protection bar with sensor connectors in position for sensors to be fitted. Install parking sensors into ECB protection bar by carefully placing sensor with original equipment silicon ring into pre-cut hole. Twist parking sensor into holder and connect wiring harness. Using a zip tie (supplied) wrap around parking sensor and attach to top of the mounting plate. Zip tie wiring harness into rear of ECB protection bar.



Stage 15

• Fit ECB LED indicator / park lights into protection bar as per instructions supplied with the LED indicator kit.



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Stage 16

- Attach ECB fog lights to protection bar. Place M6 x 20 bolts, spring washers (supplied) through light mount from inside and attach nut to top.
- Slide assembly into light mount in Protection bar and centralize light to hole. TIGHTEN FIRM ONLY.



Stage 17

• Attach 6mm clip lock trim (supplied) to top of ECB protection bar. NOTE: Trim off lower edge on an angle so trim will sit flush with end of protection bar.







Stage 18

• Splice ECB wiring harness into wiring harness behind headlight using cable locks (supplied). Ensure harness is clear of sharp edges and moving parts.

Stage 19

Connect ECB Quick Click fog light wiring harness (supplied) into original wiring harness.

Stage 20

- Using mounts as a guide, trim lower grille and styrofoam bumper support to fit.
- Refit bumper in the reverse steps of 2 to 3.

NOTE: As the development vehicle is returned to standard, the photo attached does not show cut grille fitted.



Stage 21

- Fit ECB protection bar to inside of ECB steel mounting bracket using (3) three M12 x 40 bolts flat washers, spring washers and nuts (supplied) (per side). Finger tighten only.
- Align ECB protection bar with vehicle and tighten all bolts.



Stage 22

- Connect and check operation of ECB indicator / park lights, ECB fog lights and headlamp washers. Adjust headlamp washers if required.
- Test drive vehicle to ensure all safety systems are working the same as before Protection bar was installed. Adjust as required.

Final Checks & Fitting Kit

Ensure Number Plate is Clearly Visable

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

Further VFPS Notes

- 1. Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).
- 2. Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- 3. Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- 4. Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- 5. No accessory or fitment should project forward of the VFPS forward profile.
- 6. Insure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.

Important Information

Periodically check bolts and nuts for correct tightness, especially if traveling on rough roads.
