



Product Care

Polished Products

Being a premium mirror polished finish, regular maintenance will be required to keep that iconic ECB shine. We recommend using our own brand of Aluminium Polish. This formula has been tried and tested and in our opinion is the world's best standard.

Directions: Apply a small quantity of Aluminium Polish to a clean soft cloth and rub the metal surface. The longer the rubbing the brighter the surface becomes. Wipe off Aluminium Polish with clean soft cloth. Also suitable for motorised buffing machines.

Note: There are more specific details on the polish bottle. Please read before use.

Stage 1

- Test drive vehicle to ensure all driver assists are correctly working and to gauge effectiveness. Park on a flat level surface.
- · Apply parking brake and lift bonnet.
- Unwrap ECB Protection bar and disconnect mounts. Discard bolts.
- Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.



Stage 2

 Remove eight (8) plastic push pull clips from top panel between headlights and remove panel.



- From top of grille, remove four (4) 10mm head bolts.
- Remove three (3) 10mm head bolts from top of bumper behind grille.
- From bumper behind grille, remove two (2) plastic push pull clips.
- Disconnect sonar behind Toyota logo in grille.
- · Remove grille.



Stage 4

• Remove nine (9) 10mm head bolts from underside of bumper.



Stage 5

- In front of wheel arch remove two (2) push pull plugs.
- Carefully pull rear of wing out from side of vehicle and forward to remove bumper.
- · Disconnect fog lights.



Stage 6

 Remove plastic bumper stiffener, three (3) 10mm head bolts and left and right hand air ducts.



Stage 7

- Remove plastic cushioning from front of bumper reinforcement by pulling it forward from vehicle to release christmas tree clips.
- Remove two (2) 14mm head bolts from bumper reinforcement (per side) and remove reinforcement.
- Remove lower plastic from under radiator, two (2) 10mm head bolts and five (5) push pull clips.



- Fit ECB steel mounting bracket (supplied)
 onto end of chassis rail and fix with two (2)
 original bolts and two (2) M10 x 1.5 x 40mm
 bolts, flat washers, spring washers and nuts
 (supplied) into front of rail (per side) (finger
 tighten only).
- From inside of chassis rail, install two (2) M10 x 1.5 x 100mm bolts, flat washers, washer plate and spacer tubes (supplied) through chassis rail and ECB steel mounting bracket. On outside of these bolts fit ECB steel tow hook, flat washer, spring washers and nuts (supplied).
- In rear hole of ECB steel tow hook, install 6mm alloy washer between tow hook and chassis rail, fit using one (1) M12 x 1.25 x 40mm bolt, spring washer and flat washer (supplied)(per side).
- Centralize and align mount to vehicle body.
 Tighten all bolts.





Stage 9

- Mark and trim air dams to fit around steel mounting bracket.
- Refit to vehicle, using original bolts and clips.



Stage 10

· Refit plastic bumper stiffener to vehicle.



- Check ECB template (supplied) for correct sizing.
- Cut ECB template using a sharp pair of scissors.
- Place template on vehicle to establish cut area.
- Mask cut area to avoid damage to surface of bumper. Using ECB bumper template mark out cut line, check cut line for correct.
- Carefully cut bumper with jigsaw or similar tool.



Stage 12

- Remove bumper side locater, two (2)
 plastic screw clips, one (1) 10mm head bolt
 and one (1) push pull clip on inner guard
 (per side).
- Mark and trim locator to line shown in photo.
- Refit bumper locater to vehicle using original bolts and clips.



Stage 13

 Refit bumper to vehicle and trim cut line with 3mm clip lock (supplied).



- Disconnect indicator and parking lights on vehicle. Install ECB quick click wiring harnesses (supplied) between disconnected harness and indicator / park lights on vehicle.
- Run wiring out from under lights ensuring clearance from sharp edges and moving parts.
- · Connect Quick click wiring harness to fog light harness.

Stage 15

- Attach ECB bumper lights to protection bar. Place M6 x 20 bolts, spring washers (supplied) through light mount from inside and attach nut to top. Slide assembly into light mount in Protection bar and centralize light to hole. TIGHTEN FIRMLY.
- Install bumper light surrounds (supplied) to light openings. Large side of surround to inside of opening.



Stage 16

 Fit ECB LED indicator / park lights into protection bar as per instructions supplied with the LED indicator kit.
 NOTE: Ensure park light is to top.



Stage 17

 Attach 6mm clip lock trim (supplied) to top of ECB protection bar. NOTE: Trim off lower edge on an angle so trim will sit flush on protection bar.





Stage 18

- Install ECB protection bar onto steel mounting bracket using three (3) M12 x 1.25 x 40mm bolts, flat washers, spring washers and nuts (per side)(supplied).
- Align protection bar to front of vehicle and tighten all bolts.



Stage 19

- Using ECB back stop supplied (TO AVOID DAMAGE TO RADIATORS) drill outer holes in stone tray to 8mm.
- Caution: Use back stop (supplied) to protect radiator while drilling.



Stage 20

 Install ECB centre under body guard using three (3) M5 x 20 mm philips head bolts, flat washers and nyloc nuts in front holes, M6 x 25mm bolts, flat washers and nyloc nuts (supplied) in rear holes.



Stage 21

- Install ECB side under body guards using two (2) M5 x 20mm philips head bolts, flat washers and nyloc nuts in front holes, M6 x 25mm bolts, flat washers and nyloc nuts (supplied) in rear hole (per side).
- Trim sides of liner to tuck in behind channel end
- Mark and neatly trim liner to fit under body guard. Fix liner to under body guard with 8mm self drilling screws.



Stage 22

- · Check correct operation of all lights.
- Road test vehicle to ensure correct operation of all driver assist features of the vehicle.

Ensure Number Plate is Clearly Visable

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

Further VFPS Notes

- Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).
- Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- 3. Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- 4. Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- 5. No accessory or fitment should project forward of the VFPS forward profile.
- 6. Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.

Important Information

Periodically check bolts and nuts for correct tightness, especially if traveling on rough roads.


