

Polished Products

Being a premium mirror polished finish, regular maintenance will be required to keep that iconic ECB shine. We recommend using our own brand of Aluminium Polish. This formula has been tried and tested and in our opinion is the world's best standard.

Directions: Apply a small quantity of Aluminium Polish to a clean soft cloth and rub the metal surface. The longer the rubbing the brighter the surface becomes. Wipe off Aluminium Polish with clean soft cloth. Also suitable for motorised buffing machines.

Note: There are more specific details on the polish bottle. Please read before use.

Stage 1

- Test drive vehicle to ensure all driver assists are correctly working and to gauge effectiveness. Park on a flat level surface.
- · Apply parking brake and lift bonnet.
- Unwrap ECB Protection bar and disconnect mounts. Discard bolts.
- Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.



Stage 2

 Remove two (2) 10mm head bolts and four (4) push pull clips from the top of grille.



Stage 3

 Remove underbody guard, four (4) 10mm head bolts and two (2) push pull clips.



Kia Sportage 10/18 on

Stage 4

- Remove one (1) 10mm head bolt and four (4) push pull clips per side in wheel arch.
- Disconnect fog lights per side and parking sensor harness on drivers side.



Stage 5

- CAUTION CARE NEEDS TO BE TAKEN WHEN UNCLIPPING BUMPER FROM GUARD TO AVOID TEARING AT BUMPER MOUNTING.
- Gently pull wing of bumper away from guard, small screw driver maybe needed to unclip to avoid tearing bumper skin from mount.
- · Remove bumper.



- Remove three (3) 10mm head bolts retaining the plastic air dam located below the radiator.
- Trim the upper section of the air dam away to allow clearance for the mount.
 Measure 70mm from the top.

Stage 7

- Place the steel mounting brackets supplied onto front of impact member and lightly fasten using M10 x 1.5 x 70mm bolts, flat washers, spring washers and M10 x 1.5 nuts (supplied) from the rear chassis mount backing plates.
- Align mounts with measurement from the Protection Bar and tighten all bolts.
- BOLT HEADS MUST BE AT THE RADIATOR SIDE OF THE MOUNTS.



Stage 8

Remove two (2) centre sensors from bumper.

- Place sensors into protection bar and secure with cable ties (supplied).
- NOTE DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN CABLE TIES, AS SENSORS MAY GIVE FALSE READINGS.



- Release clips in bumper for parking sensor harness to extend. Bring harness through grille so it can be connected to sensors.
- Use cable ties (supplied) to secure sonar harness.



Kia Sportage 10/18 on

Stage 10

- Measure mounts and transfer to bumper grille. Check grliie against mounts to ensure correct trim area.
- Tape area to be trimed to avoid any damage to bumper.
- Carefully trim lower grill to allow steel mounts can protrude through.



Stage 11

• Refit bumper in reverse of steps 2 to 4.



- Fit protection bar to steel mounts using M10 x 1.5 x 40mm bolts, flat washers, spring washers and M10 x 1.5 nuts (supplied).
- · Finger tighten only.

Stage 13

- Align protection bar with vehicle and tighten bolts.
- · Connect sensors



- Test drive vehicle to ensure driver aids are correctly functioning. Check operation of sensors.
- NOTE: Sensors may go off when driving off driveways. This happens when the sensor picks up the road surface.

Final Checks & Installation Kit

Ensure Number Plate is Clearly Visable

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

Further VFPS Notes

- Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).
- Do not use this product for any vehicle make or model, other than those specified by the VFPS manufacturer.
- 3. Do not remove the plaque or label from the VFPS.
- 4. Do not modify the structure of the VFPS in any way.
- 5. No accessory or fitment should project forward of the VFPS forward profile.
- 6. Ensure these instructions are left with the vehicle owner and/or operator.


