FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

FORD TERRITORY TYPE 8 04/05-04/09 models only, 63mm SERIES 2 NUDGE BAR and 76mm NUDGE BAR 04/05-04/11 models VEHICLE FRONTAL PROTECTION SYSTEM (VFPS) FOR AIR BAG & ADR COMPLIANT VEHICLES

Check installation hardware before commencing.

NOTE: 3/8 chuck, small physical size air drill or similar size electric drill is required, **otherwise remove bumper cover to gain clear access fit mounts and then refit bumper cover.**

- 1. Turn wheels full lock.
- 2. Remove lower plastic air deflector by removing thirteen 7mm head screws. Slide down and rearward to remove. **See figure 1.**
- 3. Remove two plastic push in rivets and one PK self-tapper (each side) from plastic inner guards at bumper cover side returns. See figure 2.
- 4. Support steel mounting system (supplied) on jack. See figure 3. Jack steel mounting system up onto chassis lip ensuring steel mounting system is as high as possible on chassis lip and hard against steel radiator support. See figure 4. If bumper not removed you will need to stretch forward to allow access for the mount.




Figure 5 – Drivers side shown

- 5. Clamp rear of steel mounting system to chassis lip. See figure 5.
- 6. Pull plastic inner guard clear for access. Using centre mounting holes as a guide drill one 10mm hole (each side) through chassis lip. **See figure 6.** Treat raw metal with rust inhibitor. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolts, nuts and washers (supplied). **TIGHTEN**.




Figure 7 – Drivers side shown

- 7. Remove clamps. Drill one 10mm hole (each side) through chassis lip at rear mounting holes. **NOTE:** Turn wheel lock outwards for each side for access. Treat raw metal with rust inhibitor. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolt, nuts and washers (supplied). **TIGHTEN. See figure 7**.




Figure 8 – Passenger side shown

- 8. Repeat drill procedure for front holes. See figure 8. NOTE: Bend plastic flap inside bumper cover clear to access front holes. Treat raw metal with rust inhibitor. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolt, washer on wire (supplied) to access front holes, feed from inside. See figure 9. Attach washers and nuts (supplied) TIGHTEN.
- 9. Trim wire from bolts and bend up inside bumper cover.
- 10. Reattach plastic inner guards to bumper cover.
- 11. Hold plastic air deflector against steel mounting system and mark where trimming is required to fit around steel mounting system. Trim and reattach to vehicle. See figures 10 and 11.
- 12. Attach protection bar to outside of steel mounting system. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolts, washers on wire (supplied) to access front holes. Use 3/8 x 1 ½ bolts, nuts and washers (supplied) for rear holes. Align protection bar with vehicle. NOTE: figures 12, 13 and 14 for side views, Figures 15, 16 and 17 for front views. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AND NUTS. NOTE: Ensure protection bar is mounted as high as possible on steel mounting for maximum ground clearance.



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ENSURE NUMBER PLATE IS CLEARLY VISABLE

Note: When fitting/refitting the licence plate to the vehicle, ensure there is no obstruction to licence plate vision in accordance with local authorities. If required relocate licence plate to an alternate location.

- a) Do not attach VFPS to the vehicle using anchorages not intended for this purpose (e.g. engine mounting bolts).

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
